

Amendment 1: Amendment Notification Requirements

PROPOSED BYLAW CHANGES

The original language is struck through. The proposed new language is in bold.

ARTICLE XVI **(Amendments)**

3. The Executive Committee shall prescribe the time, place and manner of conducting any such referendum, provided that the membership be given notice, both through the U.S. mail and by posting on bulletin boards, ~~of the exact question to be decided~~ at least 30 days in advance of the referendum. **That notice can direct the membership to the union's website for the exact question to be decided. Anyone without web access can request a written copy of the question.**
